UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST OFFICIALS
RE-ISSUE PERMIT FOR CARDIFF FORK ROAD

Salt Lake City, Utah, May 1, 2012 - Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest officials recently re-issued a permit to Cardiff Canyon Owners Association (CCOA) for continued year-round motorized access to their private property. As part of the permitting process, Cardiff Fork Road (Forest Road #019) will be used by landowners to access private property, and by the public to gain access to National Forest System Lands. No motorized use is permitted beyond the designated access route on National Forest System Lands. The access routes for private landowners, Forest Service employees, and the public are shown on the attached map.

Cardiff Fork is a place that holds significant value because of its outstanding historical, scenic, watershed, and recreational characteristics and mutual respect by users is critical for continued public access across private land. The Forest Service does not regulate use/activities on private land so please protect this privilege by adhering to the following:

- Stay on designated routes across private land
- Respect private property and obey no trespassing signs
- Practice positive, courteous, and respectful interactions with all users

All winter users are encouraged to practice safe and ethical winter backcountry travel – avoid skiing/snowmobiling above other parties in avalanche terrain and contact the Utah Avalanche Center at <http://utahavalanchecenter.org/> or (888)-999-4019 to obtain current weather and avalanche conditions.
